











SUCCESS AND PURE EXCITEMENT AT THE EUROPEAN AUTOCROSS CHAMPIONSHIP IN MOLLERUSSA

- The best drivers on the continent delivered huge moments of excitement and highvoltage action in the fifth edition of the Autocross of Mollerussa.
- Petr Nikodém, Danny van den Berg, Tinus Franssen and Iván Piña triumphed on the dirt of the Circuit Municipal Parc de la Serra.

Mollerussa, 12/10/2025. | The top international Autocross competition returned to Mollerussa for the fifth consecutive edition for another FIA European Autocross Championship round, where the best drivers in Europe offered the attending fans an unforgettable dose of thrill and spectacle. Petr Nikodém in SuperBuggy, Danny van den Berg in Buggy1600, Tinus Franssen in JuniorBuggy, and Iván Piña in Crosscar were the winners at the Circuit Municipal Parc de la Serra.

After Saturday's heats, which already hinted at the first battles, Sunday arrived packed with new wheel-to-wheel duels that decided the victories at stake. Following the Heats — where Nikodém, van den Berg, Ladislav Hanák, and Piña were the best in the intermediate classification — came the first decisive moments with the Semifinals.

Petr Nikodém and Zdenek Antony in SuperBuggy, Danny van den Berg and Rudy van Buren in Buggy1600, as well as Iván Piña and local driver Ares Lahoz, were the semifinal winners in each of the categories that featured one. Due to the number of entrants, there were no semifinals in JuniorBuggy, and all drivers advanced directly to the final race.

The highlight of the weekend came with Finals packed with overtakes, edge-of-the-limit

battles, and masterclasses in driving that thrilled spectators. In Crosscar, an early red flag due to an incident delayed the fight for glory, requiring a full-distance restart. Iván Piña left no chance for his rivals and led from start to finish, taking another victory to firmly strengthen his lead in the FIA European Crosscar Championship. Quim González and Pepe Arqué completed the podium in second and third place, much to the delight of the large local crowd.

The impressive SuperBuggy grid once again entertained the fans with a tight Final, from which Petr Nikodém emerged victorious after mastering the Mollerussa circuit. Behind the Czech driver, his compatriot Zdenek Antony finished second, and Dutchman Mike Bartelen took third. In Buggy1600, Danny van den Berg claimed the win, followed by Rene Mandel in second and Jakub Novotny in third. Meanwhile, Tinus Franssen took victory in JuniorBuggy, finishing ahead of Ladislav Hanák and Eliska Plná.

With the official trophy ceremony, the great celebration of the FIA European Autocross Championship came to an end, wrapping up two weeks of pure motorsport during which Mollerussa once again established itself as the international capital of Autocross, placing the Circuit Municipal Parc de la Serra as the true olympus of the discipline in Spain.
